AN HEIR OF MAGIC moved up along the inside to show the way into the turn, increased the advantage in the drive, well clear. ADVANCED SIGNS unhurried early, three wide into the lane, could do nothing with the winner in the drive, clear for the place. CHASE OUR HERO in the second flight, improved toward the inside late in the turn, moved out a bit for the drive, best of the rest. HUMBLE RICK lacked speed, fanned seven wide out of the turn, little rally in the drive while continuing far out in the strip. CELTIC STRIDER made a slight advance six wide late in the turn, also finished up evenly midtrack. SCREEN THE SAND with the pace early, four wide late in the turn, faded through the stretch. BLUE FREEO failed to menace. LAFFER'S ECHO pressed the pace, tired. CAPITAL PARK far back early, picked off a couple of tiring foes while never a threat. CATO tired outside. CASA BLANCO was through early. BEBOPPING MAN refused.
