MR EASY E allowed to settle early, chased the pace from the outside up the backstretch, advanced entering the second turn, responded to pressure entering the drive and was clear late under steady pressure. CHOP SPATS outrun early, made a bid entering the second turn, reached a striking position entering the drive, lacked room when behind rivals mid stretch, altered out but was too late. HOUSE OF USHER stalked the early pace from the outside, reached a forward position entering the drive, responded but could not match strides. FIRST MOVEMENT dueled from the outside but had nothing left. WINGS ON SPRINGS dueled from the inside but gave way.
