JORGA'S SONG behind the first flight, hard held behind rivals in the second turn, steadied repeatedly late in that bend when lacking room, got through between foes and three wide upper straight, finished well. HOLLI'S BRICKHOUSE lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, also was going well at the end while no match for the winner. CRAFTY CHESTNUT off the early pace, moved closer in traffic second turn, four wide into the lane, could not match strides with the top two late, held the show. BIEN WILD devoid of early foot in trailing early, roused off the inside, displayed some modest late interest after the issue had been decided. TROJAN BEAUTY lacked a serious late response. MICHAELANGELINA four wide in the first turn, again into the second, had little left for the drive. OILVE OIL TOO vied up front while between foes for six furlongs and gave way. DISORIENT narrowly set the pace along the inside, faltered. FLYING JAYBIRD with the pace three wide, gave way far turn.
