KOLSCH settled through the early going, gradually progressed between horses once on the backstretch, took the second bend four wide, gained the advantage upper stretch, was driven clear inside the last eighth and kept to task to the wire. CIRCUIT TAP without early foot, was taken outside on the backstretch, bid behind KOLSCH into the second turn, swung outside that one for the drive, rallied belatedly but caught FLAMING ARROWS for second near the wire. FLAMING ARROWS rated in midpack the first quarter, steadily closed the gap along the rail on the backstretch, came off the inside some on the second turn, vied for the lead two wide in the stretch but weakened the last eighth. SEEKING LARRY advanced from outside on the backstretch to share the lead four wide leaving the second turn, angled in some entering the lane, had a brief advantage, battled between horses to deep stretch and gradually faded. WEE DEE TRRR trailed, was angled in on the backstretch, picked up his pace just off the rail on the second turn, moved to the inside entering the lane, altered outside SMOKIN CHICO upper stretch, advanced to the last eighth then leveled off. POLISHED SLEWPHY was moved in between rivals early, gradually backed up going to the second bend, was three wide at the head of the lane and had no late bid. DAVID'S TIGER contested the pace from outside, had the lead three wide on the second turn, moved to the inside leaving that bend and gave way. SMOKIN CHICO dueled for the lead between rivals, angled in to have the rail leaving the second turn, began to back up at that point, lost his path then faded along the rail. LAWFIRM displayed early speed inside, quit on the second turn and lost contact with the field through the lane.
