MORE THAN A REASON showed good speed, dueled racing between rivals going down the backside, battled in a three way duel having the rail entering the stretch, dug in to edge away late under strong handling, very game effort. LIGHTNING ROAD bobbed at the break, quickly rushed running five wide down the backstretch, vied abreast around the bend, matched strides with the winner top of the lane, was out finished late, held on to the place position, good effort. C J'S MISSILE showed good speed, dueled soon after the start racing between rivals, held a slight lead at the quarter pole, started to tire mid stretch, bested rest in a game effort. DEAVER lacked speed, saved ground around the bend, asked for more, beat weary foes, never menaced. BROOKLIME (IRE) raced in good tracking position, traveled towards the inside on the turn, swung out six wide under a drive entering the stretch, failed to respond, no threat. STYLISH GOLD sent hard, vied along the rail in a four way duel, started to fade coming to the quarter pole, angled out wide upper stretch, finished spent.
