UNDERSTATEMENT set the pace along the inside, opened a wide gap in midstretch and was fully extended to hold on in the late stages. MORE THAN A REASON steadied along the inside on the first turn, saved ground for six furlongs, steadied in traffic on the turn and finished well from outside. JUDGE WILLIAM was reserved to the turn and rallied belatedly while six wide. ALEXANDROS lodged a four wide middle move on the backstretch and faded in upper stretch. OVEREXTENDED failed to mount a serious rally. SPANKY FISCHBEIN pressed the pace inside to the turn and tired. BEBOB lodged a mild inside move on the turn and flattened out. MUSICO OSO was furnished after going six furlongs. DARKSIDE HOLIDAY raced in traffic and gave way.
