PRAIRIE ACADEMY vied for the lead off the rail, took the lead in the turn and repulsed all late bids and held on. VIVA VINO vied for the lead, weakened in the long drive but held the place inside. CAPE COD BAY was taken up in the turn, angled out then closed with a rush between horses. REAPPEARANCE rushed to the lead, vied then weakened late in the drive between horses. ORIENTATED LADY steadied on the turn then made a bid widest too late. BANNER DAY checked on the backstretch, loomed boldly but was not good enough. COMMANDING JOY pressed the pace but failed to sustain the bid and drifted in the stretch. NURSE KIKI was unhurried early, moved to the leaders on the backstretch, was taken up and had no rally. RESTRAIN was void of early speed and failed to menace. CARO CITY LIGHTS had no speed and outrun. PRIMELAKE was bumped start, flashed brief foot, checked repeatedly and raced greenly.
