PERFECT VACATION attended the pace along the inside, split horses to make his bid, forged command inside the furlong marker and drew clear through the final yards. RESTLESS CITY set the pressured pace along the inside, battled through a long drive, was unable to resist the winner, but dug in to preserve the place. CODEOFTHEBAYOU broke a step slow, advanced three wide through the bend, offered a mild bid entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. CONCENTION stalked the pace three wide, drew even leaving the turn, poked his head in front briefly with a furlong to run, but failed to sustain the drive. CANADIAN BORDER was hard used to press the pace two wide, but stopped before going three furlongs.
