Footnotes

ROCK AND DEAL tracked the pace advancing four deep to the half, rallied to the top on the far turn taking a short lead into upper stretch, facing wide pressure would drift out while holding on late. STRIKE TWO raced evenly giving a prompted middle move looming on the far turn, extended between horses vied in close quarters nearing the wire. TRADE SIGNAL lunged then was crowded at the break, found stride on the far turn moving to contention abreast rivals in upper stretch, with no excuse late would hang the final sixteenth. JUST YOU AND I KID slow early was circled out while gaining into upper stretch, put down in the six path gave even late action. D. R. DANCER well placed out of the opening turn stalked close up traveling along the inside to the far turn, roused to bid there began to waver, would flatten out in upper stretch. A DEVIL OF A TRIP stalked close up racing in tight between horses to the far turn, pressured ROCK AND DEAL briefly then wilted in upper stretch. MY SECRET SERVICE sent clear was used on pace through the backside, gave way sharply on the far turn. ANOTHER DEVIL failed to respond. JULIE'S M AND N settled early gave a prompted middle move then folded up on the far turn. An objection from the rider of TRADE SIGNAL against the rider of STRIKE TWO claiming interference as the horses left the gate was disallowed by the stewards.
