ROCK AND DEAL was patiently ridden running five wide down the backstretch, quickly bid to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, dueled while between foes entering the stretch, drifted out mid stretch battling with TRADE SIGNAL, went head to head to the wire, just prevailed being fully extended. TRADE SIGNAL settled in the second flight, traveled six wide to the half, bid outside the winner entering the stretch, matched strides to the finish, was out nodded in last jumps, hard try. CHANCE'S CODE raced up close from the start, bid mid turn, took a slight lead at the quarter pole, dueled running along the rail in a three way battle entering the stretch, weakened at the sixteenth pole, bested rest. MY BUDDY DAN settled along the rail in mid pack, did mildly bid into the lane, never threatened while improving position. DE LEON lacked speed, urged far turn, gained on the bend, chased into the lane, leveled off. TRACKSIDE TOMMY was outrun to mid turn, beat weary foes, never involved. CAPITAN SOLIS was hustled to the front, set all the pace to the far turn, was collared near the three eighths pole, had nothing left and stopped at the quarter pole. SIOUXPERMAN gave a brief chase, gave way far turn, well beaten. MEMORY'S TERN hustled to stalk down the backside, was all done at the quarter pole, stopped top of the stretch, was eased coming to the finish .
