JOYFUL broke well from the inside to stalk the early pace, steadily crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, gained the advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear late under steady urging. BRICK BY BRICK up close early from the inside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, remained a forward factor through the drive but could not match strides. SHE BE SUNNY allowed to settle early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, made a bid entering the stretch but could not reach the winner. AMATURE'S PRIZE pinched back at the start, trailed the field early, responded entering the stretch and finished gamely. VESPER broke sharp from between foes to set the early pace, then tired in the drive. HALO VICTORY was no factor. SKI SKY chased the early pace inside and tired. HOPEFULLY was finished early. SCATTIN' EMMA had a steady fade.
