BEACH BEAU tracked the pace two wide, forged command leaving the three-eighths pole, was overtaken with a quarter to run, but dug in gamely and came again with renewed vigor, and drew clear through the final yards. TAP DANCING attended the pace three wide, moved with BEACH BEAU through the second turn, struck the front leaving the second turn, continued on willingly through the drive but was unable to match strides with the winner late. VICTORY NOTION settled in hand, launched his bid three wide entering the stretch, loomed large with a furlong to run but lacked the needed late response. MEMORIAL MANIAC broke a step slow and was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch to make a late gain but failed to threaten. REV CAYCE settled in the second flight, made a mild rally four wide but was never a factor. GROOM'S CAT was unhurried into stride, made a belated gain off of the inside but passed only his tiring rivals. MYNEWTRUCKNTRAILER was forwardly placed along the inside for five furlongs and tired. HAMILTON LEWIS (BRZ) opened clear to set the pace, but was headed leaving the three-eighths pole and stopped.
